The videoconference will offer two-way communication, affording members of the public the opportunity to participate in the meeting. The meeting will be recorded, and the recording will be available after the meeting. The following matters will be considered and may be acted upon at the meeting:**

1. Call meeting to order and establish quorum;
2. Discuss, consider, and take action to approve minutes of April 13, 2021 regular meeting;
3. Receive public comment (*3 minutes per speaker; but any person providing public comment through a translator is limited to six (6) minutes, unless the District uses simultaneous translation equipment in a manner that allows the Board to hear the translated public testimony simultaneously with the speaker*);
4. Receive report from District Engineer;
5. Receive recreational facilities report and take action as necessary concerning same, including, but not limited to, operations, maintenance and/or improvements related to existing recreational facilities;
6. Discuss, consider, and take action on approval of the payment of invoices and Bookkeeper’s report;
7. Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary concerning amenity center site and project;
8. Discuss, consider, and take action as necessary concerning management of District website;
9. Receive report on 2021 Legislative Session;
10. Directors’ items for next agenda and announcements from Board members;
11. Conduct Cybersecurity Training;
12. Discuss, consider, and take action to certify compliance with the elected official security awareness training and audit requirements of Texas Government Code § 2054.5191; and
13. Adjournment.
